ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO MEXICO


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1592-A

On May 16, 2000, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to OGE Energy Resources, Inc. (OGE), in DOE/FE Order No. 1592 (Order 1592) (2 FE ¶70,487) to import and export up to a combined total of 400 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery. This authorization has never been activated.

On April 13, 2009, OGE Energy Resources, Inc. notified DOE that it does not intend to utilize this authorization, and therefore requests that DOE vacate Order 1592, effective the date of this Order.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas to and from Mexico granted to OGE Energy Resources, Inc. in Order 1592 is hereby vacated, effective the date of this Order.
