ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2637-A

On May 1, 2009, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Weyerhaeuser NR Company (Weyerhaeuser) in DOE/FE Order No. 2637 (Order 2637) to import up to 20 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on May 1, 2009, and extending through April 30, 2011.

On December 14, 2009, Weyerhaeuser requested that DOE vacate Order 2637, effective November 1, 2009. Effective October 31, 2009, Weyerhaeuser's supply contracts that resulted in gas being purchased in Canada expired. Weyerhaeuser's replacement contract specified a delivery point at Sumas, WA and therefore, Weyerhaeuser will not be importing natural gas from Canada.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted to Weyerhaeuser in Order 2637 is hereby vacated, effective November 1, 2009.
