ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2613-A

On February 9, 2009, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Petro-Canada Hydrocarbons Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Petro-Canada, in DOE/FE Order No. 2613 (Order 2613) to import up to 300 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on March 4, 2009, and extending through March 3, 2011.

On October 25, 2010, DOE was notified that Suncor Energy Inc. and Petro-Canada were amalgamated on August 1, 2010 to form a new corporate entity called Suncor Energy Inc. (Suncor). As a result of the merger, Suncor requested that Order 2613 be vacated effective October 31, 2010.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted to Petro-Canada Hydrocarbons Inc. in Order 2613 is hereby vacated, effective October 31, 2010.
