Dear Ms. Moore,

North Bend OR is one of my hometowns as I lived there in the 1980's and still go there to visit family several times annually. I have been concerned and worried for several years now about the issue regarding the building of a natural gas facility which will put in jeopardy the public interest of the people I love in that area. I am asking you to please consider the **damage** that the Jordan Cove Energy Project will do not only to the environment, the safety to the public and property owners but also to the price of domestic energy and the local economy. Citizens against LNG have been working to expose the many dire consequences of such a development. I urge you to listen to their well research arguments.

In short, I am personally against this project for the following reasons:

- Jordan Cove, owned by Canadians will be making the profits not AMERICANS. Any local jobs created by this project are temporary and few.
- Obtaining natural gas from fracking is more and more being seen as detrimental. There is continued evidence that water is contaminated by fracking liquids as seen in reports from Pennsylvania.
- How can this facility be built in a recognize tsunami and earthquake zone? An earthquake of considerable magnitude could put this beautiful coast, forests and waterways in a devastating position.

The negatives, which I have just barely mentioned, outweigh any short term benefits.
