ORDER AMENDING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1367-A

On March 6, 1998, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to Enron Capital & Trade Resources Corp. in DOE/FE Order No. 1367 (Order 1367)^{1/} to import from Canada an aggregate volume of 33.1 Bcf of natural gas over ten years commencing on November 1, 1998, and extending through October 31, 2008, or for 10 years after the commencement of deliveries if deliveries begin after November 1, 1998. Deliveries began on November 1, 1998.

On October 29, 1999, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that Enron Capital & Trade Resources Corp.'s name had been changed to Enron North America Corp.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1367 is amended to substitute Enron North America Corp. as the importer of natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 1367 remain in full force and effect.
