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ORDER TECHNICALLY AMENDING
NATURAL GAS IMPORT AUTHORIZATION

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 912-A

On January 24, 1994, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 912 (Order 912) which granted Tenaska Washington Partners II, L.P. (Tenaska Partners) authorization to import from Canada up to 21,433 MMBtu per day of natural gas over a period of 20 years. Order 912 inadvertently omitted authorization to import additional quantities of gas to reimburse Northwest Pipeline Corporation for fuel required in providing transportation services to Tenaska Partners from Sumas Washington, the point of delivery into the United States. Accordingly, the first sentence of Ordering Paragraph A in Order 912 is revised to read: "Tenaska Washington Partners II, L.P. (Tenaska Partners) is authorized to import from Canada up to 21,433 MMBtu (approximately 21,433 Mcf) per day of natural gas purchased from Shell Canada Limited (Shell), plus such additional quantities as may be required to reimburse Northwest Pipeline

Company for fuel used in rendering its transportation services."
