

ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS,  
FROM AND TO CANADA AND  
TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FROM  
OTHER INTERNATIONAL SOURCES

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2056-A

On December 09, 2005, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Engage Energy Canada, L.P., in DOE/FE Order No. 2056 (Order 2056) (2 FE ¶71,054) to import and export natural gas, from and to Canada, and to import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from other international sources, up to a combined total of 1000 billion cubic feet of natural gas. The term of the authority began on January 1, 2005, and extends through December 31, 2006.

On October 31, 2006, Engage Energy Canada, L.P. notified DOE that it had discontinued operations under its current authorization, and as a result the authorization is no longer needed.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2056, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Canada, and the import of LNG from other international sources, is hereby vacated.
